University of Baltistan, Skardu - Kinship Scholarship

Are you an undergraduate student at UoBS with siblings enrolled here too?

The Student Financial Aid Office is pleased to announce the Kinship Scholarship program for 2024. This scholarship helps families with multiple children pursuing higher education at UoBS by providing tuition fee waivers.

Who is eligible?

- **You are the eldest sibling currently enrolled as an undergraduate at UoBS.**
- You have one or more siblings who are also currently enrolled as undergraduates at UoBS.
- All siblings must maintain a strong academic record (minimum CGPA of 2.80).

Scholarship Breakdown:

- **Two Siblings:** One sibling receives a 25% tuition fee waiver.
- **Three or More Siblings:** The third sibling and any following siblings receive a 50% tuition fee waiver.
- **The scholarship will be awarded to the senior siblings;** the most junior or latest enrolled student will not be eligible for the scholarship.

Important Notes:

- In the event of multiple applications from families with more than two siblings, priority will be given to students with demonstrated financial need.
- This scholarship is for undergraduates only, not applicable to postgraduate programs, diplomas, or short courses.
- It cannot be combined with other scholarship, tuition waivers or discounts.
- The scholarship is for the 2024 academic year, subject to renewal based on continued enrollment and good academic standing.

How to Apply:

Applications will be available starting March 26, 2024, and will be accepted until April 1, 2024: Please fill out the Google Form first. After completing the online form, print it out and submit it to **Campus Administrators/SFAO.**

Required Documents: The following documents must be enclosed with the hard copy of the form:

- Kinship Scholarship application form (available March 26th)
- Proof of sibling relationship (Form B)
- Copies of parents' CNICs
- Each sibling's academic transcripts
- Proof of sibling's enrollment (student ID cards)
- Income certificate (father/family/guardian)
